Frequently Asked Questions – Booking & Breeding Shed

Booking Hours: Weekdays 8am-4:30pm, Weekends/Holidays 8am-1pm

1. What is the preferred method of booking a mare?

To request a Breeding Time, **please text 859-325-3921 within Booking Hours**, or you may call our main office number, 859-885-3345, and ask for **Booking**.

Booking via Email is NOT accepted.

2. What is the timeline for booking a mare to a stallion and how soon should I notify the Booking Office of my mare's expected breeding date?

When your mare is getting near her ideal breeding date, we suggest getting her on the books a couple of days in advance. When she's ready to breed, text/call for a time **the day before**.

3. Is there anything I need to bring with the mare or send with the van driver on the day of breeding?

All mares that visit our shed must be accompanied by a shed form.

4. What vaccines does my mare need to have prior to visiting the breeding shed?

All mares must be vaccinated for EHV-1 between **7-90 days prior** to visiting our shed and the date and product used listed on the shed form or culture.

5. What is considered a clean culture and when do I need to have one completed?

A Clean Culture is one that is taken during the same heat cycle on which your mare is being bred.

6. How is the order of mares determined at the scheduled time of breeding?

Mares are bred in the order in which they arrive at the breeding shed, except in special pre-arranged circumstances. Mares being bred to Early Voting will always be bred last, regardless of when the mare arrives.

7. What is your policy on double covers and foal heats?

We do not offer doubles or foal heat covers until **after May 1**.

8. Is a Coggins required and do I need to have a current Coggins done on my mare prior to visiting the breeding shed?

We do not require a Coggins. However, we recommend a Health Cert and Coggins be kept in your van/truck.

9. Who should I contact in case of an emergency such as a last-minute cancellation or late arrival?
